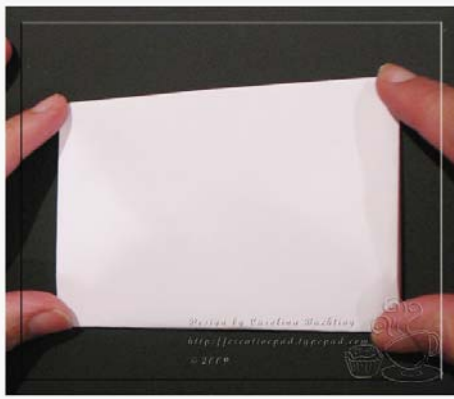


Purse-a-Lope

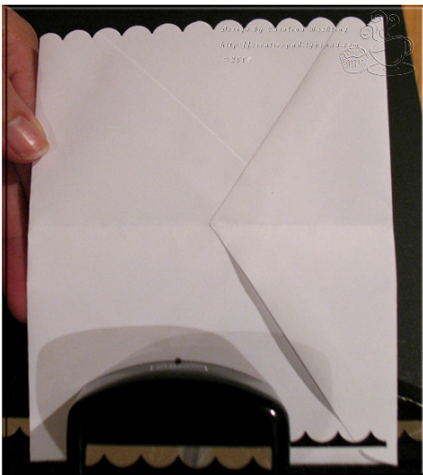

1. Seal envelope and fold envelope in half lengthwise.



2. Use the Scallop Border Punch to scallop the top edges (the non-fold side)



3. Seal with Sticky strips...4 strips, 2 on each side being CAREFUL to start tape just above the fold and right below scallop edge on both sides.

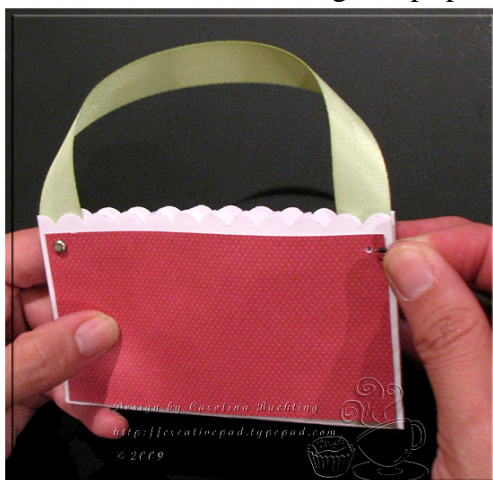


4. Use 8" inches of ribbon to create a handle. Remove Sticky strip on the top half in order to adhere ribbon. Then remove the two remaining strips to seal halves together.



On front of purse-a-lope

1. Adhere Designer Paper (4 1/4 x 2 1/4") to front of the purse-a-lope. Add two brads to corners of the designer paper and set it aside.



2. Stamp your sentiment or image on a piece of Whisper White card stock, cut it out, and adhere it on top of the designer paper using Stampin' Dimensionals. The sentiment here is from the Sale-a-Bration set called Yummy.



On the back of Purse-a-Lope

1. Punch two little hearts using Heart to Heart Punch to cover the backside of brads.



2. Stamp sentiment at the bottom (here I used "With Love" from the Yummy Sale-a-Bration Stamp set). You are done...fill each section with Chocolate or treat of your choice!
